Renegades! We are happy to announce that the ASOC Needs-Based Grant is open once again. This is a wonderful opportunity for those experiencing financial stress, who can use a helping hand. If you have been feeling overwhelmed by the payments for your education and essentials, you should consider applying for the ASOC's Needs-Based Grant.

What is the Needs-Based Grant?

This grant aims to offset the financial stress of students by providing a way for students to pay off and/or cover the costs that they might incur in relation to their educational-related expenses and/or food expenses.

Who can apply?

All students can apply, part-time and full-time students alike.

What are the requirements to qualify?

To qualify students must currently have and maintain a 2.5 GPA as well as be enrolled in a minimum of 5 units. Additionally, an application must also be filled out to assess the student's financial needs.

How many people will receive this grant and how much will each individual receive?

For Spring 2021, this grant will be awarded to 20 students, providing each with a payment of \$250.
